

STREET VIEW - ART KNOWLEDGE ORGANISER YEAR 1

PRIOR LEARNING

In Reception, the children learnt to name the primary colours and explored secondary colours. They learnt that art can be made out of anything, including collage and mixed media. Children chose collage materials for a purpose. They learnt to add detail to drawings, make thick and thin lines and use a variety of tools for painting. They also explored printing.

DRAW A PLACE FROM OBSERVATION

Pupils will head outside to look at buildings. They will sketch a chosen building carefully and take photographs of it.

CK - Pupils know a sketch or drawing of a place or space is called a landscape

IDENTIFY SIMILARITIES AND DIFFERENCES BETWEEN TWO OR MORE PIECES OF ART

Pupils will look at a variety of images and pieces of art. They will describe them, share their likes and dislikes and compare them.

CK - Pupils know that Art on a similar theme can be different because of the colours or style the artist uses

DESCRIBE AND EXPLORE THE WORK OF A SIGNIFICANT ARTIST

Pupils will study the work of James Rizzi, creating their own piece based on his work.

CK - Pupils know James Rizzi was a significant American artist and illustrator

IDENTIFY AND USE PAINTS IN THE PRIMARY AND SECONDARY COLOURS

Pupils will look at the colours in the work of James Rizzi. They will create their own colour wheel, showing primary and secondary colours.

CK - Pupils know secondary colours are made by mixing primary colours. They are purple, green and orange.

MANIPULATE PAPER AND CARD BY CUTTING, LAYERING AND OVERLAPPING

The children will discuss how James Rizzi created form by using layers of foam to create a 3-D effect. They will use card and paper to create a 3D effect.

CK - Pupils know 3-dimensional art is not flat like 2-dimensional art

CREATE A LANDSCAPE BASED ON THE WORK OF A SIGNIFICANT ARTIST

Pupils will plan, create and evaluate their own work of a place in Charminster based on Rizzi.

CK - Pupils know a landscape art can include things that are natural and things that are human made.

KEY ARTIST



JAMES RIZZI

James Rizzi (1950 – 2011) was an American pop artist who was born and raised in New York. He made fun cityscapes, such as Back in Brooklyn; City Day – City Night and Happy Town.

HOME LEARNING

Your challenge is to draw a picture of a place that is special to you. For example, it could be your house, the park or the beach. We can't wait to see your artwork!

KEY VOCABULARY

Composition - the way in which a piece of art has been put together or arranged.

Mood - a feeling that the artist wants to make you feel or understand. Often when an artist uses colour in a painting they are trying to communicate an emotion, mood or atmosphere.

Observe - to look closely at

Observational drawing - drawing what you can see.

3D - stands for three-dimensional, not flat.

Primary colours - colours that cannot be made from other colours. These are red, blue and yellow.

Secondary colours - colours that can be made by mixing primary colours. These are orange, green and purple.
